Memory Trains Catalog Grading Standard

P10 - Mint Catalog may have been touched by human hands since leaving the factory. No rusty staples, creases, tears, fading, and/or wear marks are present.

P9 - Near Mint Catalog has been touched by human hands since leaving the factory. Original paper folds are crisp with no damage and staples may show some discoloration but not affected the paper.

P8 - Very Good Catalog show signs of minimal surface wear beginning to show, possibly including some minute wear at corners. Notations (Rubber Stamped) from an auction or dealer on the cover or interior page may be present.

P7 - Good Plus Catalog has moderate sign of cover wear beginning to show, possibly including minor creases. Staples may be rusty and not affecting the paper.

P6 - Good Catalog has above-average copy that shows minor wear but is still relatively flat and clean with no significant creasing or other serious defects. Blunted corners or minutely damaged edges are more common, as is minor staining, soiling and discoloration.

P5 - Fair Catalog shows high signs of usage. The pages show more yellowing in color and some may be missing or loose.

P4 - Poor Catalog is so heavily damaged that it has almost no collector value.
